The 16 best competitors (however all clear rounds) from the 1^{st} round qualify for the 2nd round. The 8 best competitors (however all clear rounds) from the 2^{nd} round qualify for the winning round. All competitors start with 0 penalty points.

The competing order in the 2nd round will be the reverse order of the ranking in the first round. For the second round, allowed the 25 better competitors after the first round.(however all clear round).

Jump-off against the clock for the first place if equality in the faults.
